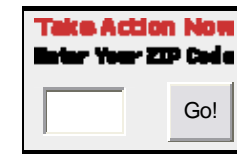


## Congressional Legislation Details

To amend titles XVIII, XIX, and XXI of the Social Security Act to extend and improve the children's health insurance program, to improve beneficiary protections under the Medicare, Medicaid, and the CHIP program, and for other purposes.

08/01/2007: Rules Committee Resolution H. Res. 594 Reported to House. Rule provides for consideration of H.R. 3162 with 2 hours of general debate. Previous question shall be considered as ordered without intervening motions except motion to recommit with or without instructions. Measure will be considered read. Bill is closed to amendments.

08/01/2007: Rule H. Res. 594 passed House.

08/01/2007: Considered under the provisions of rule H. Res. 594.

08/01/2007: H.AMDT.729 Amendment in the nature of a substitute reported by the House Committee on Rules. Pursuant to the provisions of H. Res. 594, the text of the amendment reported by the Committee on Ways and Means, modified by the Part A amendment reported by the Committee on Rules shall be considered as adopted and be made in order as original text.

08/01/2007: H.AMDT.729 On agreeing to the Rules amendment (A001) Agreed to without objection.
